WIRELESS ACCESS

Free wireless access is available. The wireless network is compatible with 802.11b of 802.11g standard and uses WPA encryption. Library Patrons are cautioned that when using any wireless connection it is possible that information sent to and from your notebook, laptop computer or other wireless device may be captured by a third party with their own wireless devices and software unbeknownst to library staff. The library assumes no responsibility for the actions of third parties that attempt to do this.

It is the Patron's responsibility to know if their equipment has wireless functionality. This can be done by checking with the manufacturer or supplier of their equipment. The Library assumes no responsibility for the safety of equipment or notebook/laptop computer or other wireless device configurations, security or data files resulting from a wireless internet connection at the Spruce Grove Public Library.

PROCEDURE

An encrypted access key must be obtained from library staff to access the wireless network. An encrypted key is a series of letters and numbers that you must enter when prompted to do so in order to make the initial connection to the library's wireless service. Encrypted keys are changed on a regular basis to maintain an adequate level of security.

The Spruce Grove Public Library has tried to make wireless access as available as possible in our library, but Patrons may encounter some "dead" spots in the library where wireless reception may be limited. No guarantee can be made that a successful connection will be made. It is suggested that the Patron move to another location within the library if they have trouble connecting or staying online. Library staff is NOT able to provide technical service.

By choosing to use this free service, the Patron agrees to abide by the Spruce Grove Public Library Boards Public Internet Policy. Failure to follow policies and procedures will result in the loss of wireless privileges.
